

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Winter arrives on December 21, which means that we will probably have snowfall and cold weather. In light of that knowledge, it is always wise to review our policy in terms of winter weather. In general, it will not be our policy to cancel our Sunday services at 8:30 or 11 am. We have a plan to clear and salt the parking lot in time for service, so the church will be accessible. The same is true for our Christmas Eve services.

The decision to cancel Sunday services or Christmas Eve services (in the case of truly dangerous weather conditions) will be made by 7:30 am on Sunday morning or by 5 pm on Christmas Eve. Cancellations will be communicated on our website <http://fpcpa.org/>, on our Facebook page, or by calling the church office and checking the greeting.

Daytime: If the Port Angeles public schools are closed due to weather-related problems, the office will be closed and daytime events will be canceled until 5 pm. If day events were canceled, evening events are canceled unless participants hear otherwise from their program leader. If the schools are running late call the church office to see if the church will be open.

If conditions keep you from traveling, then please take caution and stay home.

No event requires your attendance if you feel that weather conditions are dangerous. It is your right and responsibility to determine whether it is safe and/or wise to travel when road conditions may be hazardous.
