Sixth Sunday after Epiphany Sunday, February 16, 2025 Psalm 138, *Luke 5:1-11 "From now on..."

This passage in Luke is often entitled, "Jesus Calls the First Disciples." (Note: titles like these do not appear in the original Greek but have been added since to make it easier for modern readers to locate stories in the Bible.) Strangely, however, this call story lacks an actual 'call.' Jesus does not ask these fishermen anything. Instead, he makes a statement, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching people." From now on... It makes one wonder what Jesus has in store for followers who don't yet know they are followers. Could it be that Jesus has plans for us, and we just don't know it yet?

Seventh Sunday after Epiphany Sunday, February 23, 2025 2 Kings 5:1-14, *Luke 5:12-16 "I Do Choose"

A man with leprosy begs Jesus to be healed, "Lord, if you choose, you can make me clean." It sounds like a desperate plea for help. Looking closer, it is actually quite a statement of faith in Jesus' power to heal. The man has determined that Jesus is the key to his healing, only Jesus has the power to make him whole again. The only question is whether Jesus will choose to do so. In dramatic fashion, Jesus reaches out and touches the man. Two things happen: Jesus, by virtue of touching an untouchable, becomes ritually unclean; he also risks contamination (at least according to the medical wisdom of Jesus' time). Jesus heals the man and sends him to the priest to be restored to the worship community and to share his testimony.
